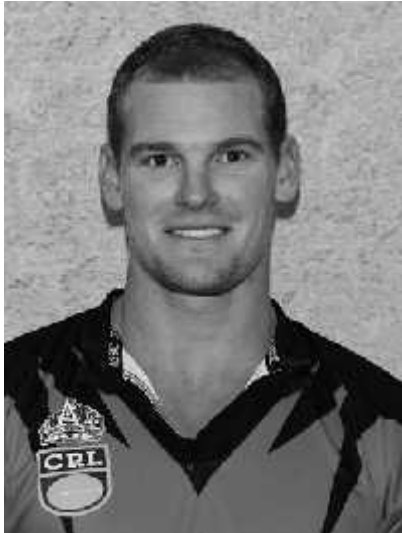

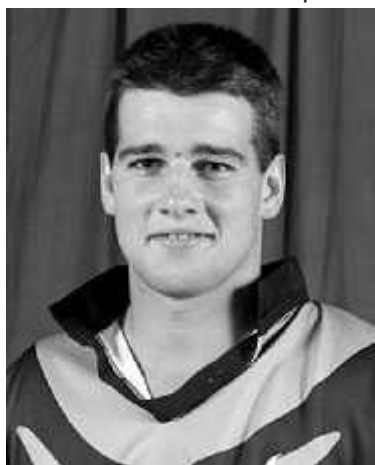

Our team finished in first spot on the points table scoring 264 to 14 in the seven game series. They then met South Sydney at Parramatta Stadium in the semi final. The other semifinal was between Penrith, who were also unbeaten, and Parramatta. Five of the Illawarra team – Jason Seadon, Robert Walsh, John Simon, David Riolo, John Cross – backed up and played for City in the Rep match against Country at Gosford. From this a NSW team to play in Queensland was selected.

It was all systems go for our Ball Cup team for the final, after their convincing win over South Sydney on a Redfern Oval mud heap in the semifinal.
